## **SC Business Leader to Speak**

Darla Moore is President of Rainwater, Inc. on the largest private Investment firms in America. Rainwater has primarily engaged in the founding and building of major companies in the health care service, oil service, natural gas, insurance, and real estate industries. She is a general partner in Goff Moore Strategic Partners, also a general investment firm.

Ms. Moore is affiliate with a number of pretegiuous Corporate and not-for-profit Boards of Directors. She is the Chairman of the Finance Committee for the board of Magellan Health Services, Inc., the country's largest mental and behavioural healthcare mangement company. In addition, she serves on the Governor's Commission on teacher Quality, the South Carolina Chamber Excellence in Education Council and the Commission on Higher Education Business Advisory Council.

Ms. Moore is the first woman to be profiled on the cover of Fortune Magazine and was named to their list of the top 50 Most Powerful Women in Ameriucan Business.
