BRUCE YANDLE



Bruce Yandle is Interim Dean of Clemson University’s College of Business & Behavioral Science, where he has been a faculty member since 1969. Bruce has served in Washington on two occasions. He was a senior economist on the President’s Council on Wage & Price Stability during the Ford and Carter administrations and was Executive Director of the Federal Trade Commission during the Reagan administration. Author/editor of a dozen books on regulation, Dr. Yandle has served as board member and as chairman of the S.C. State Board of Economic Advisors, as director of Clemson’s Strom Thurmond Institute, and as chairman of the board of trustees of Spartanburg Methodist College. He is a Senior Fellow with the Property and Environment Research Center in Bozeman, Montana, and a faculty member with George Mason University’s Capitol Hill Campus. Prior to pursuing a career in university teaching, Bruce was in the industrial machinery business for 15 years. He received his MBA and PhD degrees from Georgia State University.
