Florida, USA - Hurricane

In August 2004, Hurricane Charley hit Florida with winds sustained at 140 mph and gusts at 180 mph. There were direct hits to Sanibel/Captiva Island, Fort Myers Beach, Cape Coral, Punta Gorda, Port Charlotte and Arcadia. Each of these cities has at least one Rotary club, and more than 300 Rotarians were affected by the disaster. Thirty-three Floridians were killed, thousands were injured, and billions of dollars worth of property was damaged. The district has requested that Rotarians assist in the relief effort and have already received US\$84,000 and pledges for another \$50,000. District 6960 is collecting funds to assist individuals, including Rotarians, whose homes and businesses were destroyed by the hurricane. The following items will also be purchased and distributed: diapers, toilet paper, wet wipes, blankets, baby food and formula, cleaning supplies, paper products, bug spray, hygiene products, towels, and t-shirts.
