Please answer the following questions. Your response must be presented professionally. Use font and size that is legible and consider adding photographs were appropriate to illustrate your community service work.

1. What are your academic and future career goals?
2. Describe the community service work that you have been involved in: church or community service groups, athletics, academic clubs, individual tutoring or other services. Describe how this work has impacted you personally; how it has improved the lives of those recipients of your service; and why you feel service to others is important.
3. If you are awarded this scholarship, you will be required to perform 100 hours of community service each year to continue to receive the award in future years. What ideas do you have for potential community service involvement while in college? How do you plan to manage your schedule to balance academics and the service work at the same time?
4. How will the Rotary Club of Greenville “Service Above Self” Scholarship help you reach your goals?
5. Are there any special circumstances that you feel The Rotary Club of Greenville should know in considering your application?
